## **US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange evening lane closure for March 31, 2011**

---

**(San Antonio)** – Weather permitting, the following evening lane closures will on Thursday, March 31, 2011 from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m.

### **Exit Ramp Closure – Westbound Loop 1604 at Bitters Road**

Westbound exit to Bitters Road - on Thursday, March 31, 2011 from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. the exit ramp and shoulder at this location, on Loop 1604 will be closed to allow for guardrail replacement in this area.

Traffic wishing to use Bitters Road from westbound Loop 1604 will need to exit the Stone Oak / Voight Drive exit from Loop 1604 and use the frontage road in this area to access Bitters Road.

No other lane closures are anticipated as part of this work at this time.

This is considered an emergency closure for this type of repair work

All non-emergency work and scheduled lane closures will be provided at least five days in advance of the closure for this project.
