US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange Project nightly lane closures scheduled for May 23 – May 25, 2011

(San Antonio) – Weather permitting, the following evening lane closures will occur Monday, May 23, 2011 through Wednesday, May 25, 2011 for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project.

May 23 – 25, 2011 - Exit Ramp from Loop 1604 EB to Gold Canyon/ Redland will be closed

Closure: The eastbound 1604 right lane will be closed from the 281 overpass for ½ mile. This includes the eastbound 1604 exit ramp to Gold Canyon/Redland and the eastbound left frontage lane.

Date/Time: Lane closures will begin Monday, May 23 and end Wednesday, May 25, 2011; from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Alternate Route: Traffic that normally uses this ramp will need to use the US 281 exit.

Activity: Construction crews will be placing concrete barrier.

May 24 - 25, 2011 - Exit Ramp from Loop 1604 WB to Voigt/Stone Oak Parkway will be closed

Closure: The westbound 1604 exit to Voigt /Stone Oak Parkway will be closed

Date/Time: Tuesday, May 24, 2011 and Wednesday, May 25, 2011; from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Alternate Route: Traffic that normally uses this exit ramp will need to exit at the US 281.

Activity: Construction crews will begin to re-stripe and shift barriers on the exit ramp off of Loop 1604
