Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project

(San Antonio) – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

***This closure has been updated to reflect weekend work during the daytime.**

Loop 1604 WB frontage, main lane and Stone Oak exit ramp closures

Closure: Loop 1604 westbound frontage left lane and Loop 1604 westbound right main lane (adjacent to Wal-Mart) included with this closure is the Loop 1604 westbound exit ramp to Stone Oak.

Date/Time: Monday, November 14 – Monday, November 28, 2011. This is a nightly closure from 10:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.

***Weekend daytime closure:** Closures will begin Saturday, November 19 at 11:00a.m. and reopen Monday, November 21 at 5:00 a.m. This same closure will take place the following weekend Saturday, November 26 11:00 a.m. and reopen Monday, November, 28 at 5:00a.m.

Alternate Route: Traffic will use the US 281 exit ramp as an alternate route to the Stone Oak exit ramp closure.

Activity: Construction crews will begin placing the concrete beams for the direct connectors.
