## **Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project**

---

**(San Antonio)** – Weather permitting, the following closure will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

### **October 28 – November 1, 2011 – US 281 NB to SB turnaround will be closed**

The US 281 northbound to southbound turnaround (adjacent to HEB) will be closed starting Friday, October 28 until Tuesday, November 1, 2011 at 5:00 a.m. The detour for this closure is the US 281 / Loop 1604 intersection. Construction crews will place steel for the direct connectors.

### **October 31 – November 2, 2011 – US 281 NB frontage lane will be closed**

The US 281 northbound left frontage lane (adjacent to HEB) will closed Monday, October 31 at 10:00 p.m. and reopen Tuesday, November 1 at 5:00 a.m. Crews will close the frontage lane again on Tuesday, November 1 at 10:00 p.m. and reopen the lane on Wednesday, November 2 at 5:00 a.m. Construction crews will work to place steel for the direct connectors.

### **October 31 – November 27, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB to WB turnaround at US 281 will be closed**

The Loop 1604 eastbound to westbound turnaround at US 281 will be closed starting Monday, October 31, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and reopen Sunday, November 27, 2011. Traffic that normally uses this turnaround will be detoured to us the Loop 1604 / US 281 intersection.

### **Closure extended – November 7, 2011- Loop 1604 WB to EB turnaround at Stone Oak**

The Loop 1604 westbound to eastbound turnaround at Stone Oak closure has been extended to Monday, November 7, 2011. Traffic that normally uses this turnaround will be asked to continue to use the Stone Oak / Loop 1604 intersection.

### **Closure extended – November 30, 2011- US 281 SB Exit to Donella/ Thousand Oaks**

The US 281 southbound main lane exit ramp to Donella/Thousand Oaks closure has been extended until Wednesday, November 30, 2011. Traffic will continue to be detoured to use the Loop 1604 exit. Construction crews are continuing to drill for the direct connectors.
