Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project

(San Antonio) – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

August 20 - 21, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB right lane and shoulder will be closed from Stone Oak Parkway exit to Stone Oak bridge

The Loop 1604 eastbound right main lane and shoulder will be closed after the Stone Oak Parkway exit ramp to the Stone Oak bridge. The closure will take place Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 from 6:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. Construction crews will install new barriers and begin striping.

August 20 - 21, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB frontage lane from Stone Oak Parkway to the US 281 exit ramp will be closed

The Loop 1604 eastbound frontage left lane will be closed starting from Stone Oak Parkway (in front of the Valero) to the US 281 exit ramp (Afton Oaks). The closure will take place Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 from 6:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. Construction crews will install new barriers and begin striping.

New August 22, 2011 – Loop 1604 WB Exit Ramp at Stone Oak Parkway will be closed

The Loop 1604 westbound Stone Oak Parkway exit ramp will be closed temporarily Monday, August 22, 2011 from 8:30 a.m. till 11:30 a.m. Traffic that normally uses this exit ramp will be directed to use the US 281 exit from Loop 1604. In addition, the left frontage lane from the closed Stone Oak Parkway exit to Hardy Oaks will be closed. Construction crews will begin pouring concrete for the direct connectors.
