Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project

(San Antonio) – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

October 1, 2011 – Loop 1604 WB exit to Stone Oak Parkway will be closed

The Loop 1604 westbound main lane exit to Stone Oak Parkway will be closed on Saturday, October 1, 2011 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Traffic that normally uses the Stone Oak Parkway exit will be asked to use the US 281 exit. Construction crews will pour concrete for the direct connectors.

October 4, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB exit to Gold Canyon will be closed

The Loop 1604 eastbound main lane exit to Gold Canyon will be closed on Tuesday, October 4, 2011 from 3:00 a.m. until 6:00 a.m. Traffic that normally uses the Gold Canyon exit will be asked to use the US 281 exit. Construction crews will pour concrete for the direct connectors.

October 4 - 18, 2011 – US 281 SB exit to Donella/Thousand Oaks will be closed for TWO weeks

The US 281 southbound main lane exit ramp to Donella/Thousand Oaks will be closed from Tuesday, October 4, 2011 starting at 9:00 a.m. and will reopen Tuesday, October 18, 2011. Traffic will be detoured to use the US 281 exit. Construction crews will use the two weeks to drill for the direct connectors.
