## **Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project**

---

**(San Antonio)** – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

### **July 26, 2011 - Loop 1604 WB inside main lane will be closed from the US 281 Exit to Stone Oak Parkway Exit**

The westbound 1604 inside main lane will be closed from the US 281 exit and remain closed through the Stone Oak Parkway exit. Drivers will be directed to exit at Stone Oak Parkway (where both 1604 westbound main lanes will be closed) and re-enter Loop 1604 westbound at the Hardy Oaks entrance ramp. This closure will take place Tuesday, July 26, 2011 from 10:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. Construction crews will be moving equipment.

### **July 30, 2011 – US 281 frontage lane closure from Loop 1604 south to Donella and Donella/ Thousand Oaks Exit Ramp at US 281 will be closed**

The US 281 frontage road left lane will be closed beginning south of Loop 1604 to Donella Road. This closure includes the US 281 exit ramp to Donella/Thousand Oaks. Traffic that normally uses this exit will be directed to use the Loop 1604/ Sonterra exit. The closures will begin Saturday, July 30, 2011 at 6:00 a.m. and are scheduled to reopen at 3:00 p.m. Construction crews will restripe and place traffic barriers on US 281 southbound frontage road.

### **August 1- 15, 2011 – Turn around at Loop 1604 WB to Loop 1604 EB at US 281 will be closed**

The Loop 1604 westbound to eastbound turnaround at US 281 will be closed; the turnaround is located in front of the HEB corner parking lot. The turnaround will close Monday, August 1, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and open on Monday, August 15, 2011 at 5 a.m. Traffic that normally uses this turn around will need to use the Loop 1604/ US 281 intersection for turnaround ability. Construction crews will close the turn around to begin drilling for future concrete placement.
