



Ms. Terry M. Brechtel serves as Executive Director of the Alamo Regional Mobility Authority, the local entity responsible for improving mobility by accelerating transportation projects to deliver congestion relief and enhance the economic vitality of the region.

The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority is an independent governmental agency created by the Texas Transportation Commission and the Bexar County Commissioners Court in December 2003.

The Alamo RMA currently has a number of active projects underway including the ongoing environmental impact statements on US 281 and Loop 1604, is developing a \$1.7 Billion capital improvement program for these corridors, constructing the US 281/Loop 1604 Interchange Southern Connectors and has completed the US 281 Super Street.

Ms. Brechtel previously served as City Manager for the City of San Antonio, Texas. While with the City, she also served as Executive Director of Administrative and Financial Services, Director of Budget and Management Analysis and Director of Budget and Employee Services.

Ms. Brechtel serves on the Board of Directors of the International Bridge Tunnel & Turnpike Association. She is a member of the Texas Women's Forum. Ms. Brechtel is actively involved in civic projects serving as Co-Chair of the Women and Girls Development Fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation and Treasurer of the Artist Foundation of San Antonio.

She was inducted into the San Antonio Women's Hall of Fame in 2002 and awarded the Hidalgo de San Antonio de Bejar in 2004 by the Bexar County Commissioners for her public service.
