## **Alamo RMA to host first Community Open House on Wurzbach Parkway**

**(SAN ANTONIO)** – January 11, 2007 – The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (Alamo RMA) will host the first community open house on the proposed Wurzbach Parkway and Interchange Project on Thursday, January 25, 2007 starting at 6:00 p.m. at the Blossom Athletic Center in the Littleton Gymnasium.

There will be no formal presentation as part of the open house.

“The Alamo RMA will continue to seek new ways to involve our community. We want our community involved at the start of our projects to ensure the community’s voice and concerns are heard during the planning and evaluation of options and alternatives for each project,” said Terry Brechtel, Executive Director of the Alamo RMA.

The Alamo RMA will be conducting an environmental study for all three segments of Wurzbach Parkway which have not yet been constructed, a length of approximately 5.3 miles.

Attendees will be asked to visit five separate information stations during the open house, and provide their comments and input at each station. The stations include information and visuals on existing conditions, hike and bike trails, and interchange design options. Alamo RMA staff and a court reporter will be available to take public comment as part of the official record of the open house.

Additionally, the open house will have facilitated small table discussions on issues related to the proposed project.

“This is the first step in the public process to evaluate improvements for this corridor. We encourage the community to come be a part of the first open house, and to provide us their comments and input as we move forward with the environmental study for this project,” said Brechtel.

In keeping with Alamo RMA policy, copies of all handouts from the open house will be available on the Alamo RMA website ([www.AlamoRMA.org](http://www.AlamoRMA.org)) by 10:00 a.m. on January 26, 2007.

To be included as part of the public record for this open house, all public comments must be received by the Alamo RMA no later than 5 p.m. on February 9, 2007. Comments can be made via email, fax, or postal mail. Contact information is contained on the Alamo RMA website.
