(SAN ANTONIO) – August 7, 2006 – The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (Alamo RMA) will host the third of five community workshops to discuss transportation-funding issues on Tuesday, August 15, 2006 at St. Philip's College, Heritage Room, 1801 Martin Luther King Drive, 78203. The doors will open at 6 p.m. for an open house with various transportation agencies. The workshop begins at 7 p.m. The public is invited to attend.

Participants will have the opportunity to participate in an exercise to learn about and better understand the scope of the region's transportation challenges. The exercise, featuring facilitated small group discussions, is designed to provide the community with knowledge of transportation funding, transportation planning and the role of the agencies involved with planning, implementing and managing the regional transportation system.

This series of workshops will address general transportation issues and will supplement information to be provided at project specific meetings occurring this summer.

In addition to having questions answered by Alamo RMA staff, citizens will also be able to gather information from other transportation agencies.
